AYU0035) to start 01 new PG course with 06 seats in the subject namely (i) Shalyatantra - 06 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24 and Denial of Letter of Permission to start 01 new PG courses with 06 seats in the subject namely i) Agad Tantra - 06 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. I am to refer to your application vide ref. no. **GJPIASR/2022/2581 dated 19.10.2022**, on the subject cited above and to verify the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff and other facilities available at your college namely **Govindbhai Jorabhai Patel, Ayurveda College and Research Centre B/h G.I.D.C, New Vallabh Vidyanagar, Taluka; Dist. Anand-388121, Gujarat (Inst. ID. AYU0035) to start 02 new PG courses with 12 seats in the subject namely (i) Shalya Tantra and (ii) Agad Tantra and Vidhi Vaidyaka with 06 seats in each subject from the academic session 2023-24**, visitation has been carried out for issuance of Letter of Intent (LoI) on **08.06.2023 & 09.06.2023 through hybrid mode** by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board (NCISM) and Letter of Intent (LoI) has been issued to your college vide letter of **even no. dated 22.07.2023 to start 02 new PG courses with 12 seats in the subject namely (i) Shalya Tantra and (ii) Agad Tantra and Vidhi Vaidyaka with 06 seats in each subject under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2023-24.**
2. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the college again on **31.08.2023 and 01.09.2023 through Hybrid mode** to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities available as a part of **visitation for issuance of Letter of Permission to start 02 new PG courses with 12 seats in the subject namely (i) Shalya Tantra - 06 seats and (ii) Agad Tantra and Vidhi Vaidyaka - 06 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2023-24.**
3. Further, in view of above assessment report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Education) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020.
4. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the **59th Board Meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **18.09.2023**. On careful examination of the assessment report, **Board discussed the same and decided to provide an opportunity of virtual hearing for issuance of Letter of permission to start 02 new PG courses** vide letter of **even no. dated 26.09.2023** to appear on **27.09.2023**
5. WHEREAS, the college through its representatives, **Dr. Chandulal Hanshraj bhai Babaria (Principal)** appeared before the Hearing Committee on 27.09.2023 and made their submission virtually as well as written

submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the Ayurveda college and observations made by the hearing Committee are as under:-

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6. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate education) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 62nd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 04.10.2023 and Board verified the same and found that the college is fulfilling the eligibility criteria for issuance of Letter of Permission to start 01 new PG course with 06 seats in the subject namely (i) Shalyatantra - 06 seats and not fulfilling the criteria for issuance of Letter of permission to start 01 new PG courses with 06 seats in the subject namely i) Agad Tantra -06 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24 due to following reason:-

As per sub regulation (7) of Regulation 6 of PG MSR Ayurveda 2016, The minimum additional teaching staff required for starting post-graduate course shall be one Professor or Reader and one Lecturer of the concerned subject, in addition to the teachers stipulated for under-graduate teaching, and the specialty which does not exist as independent department at under-graduate level shall have minimum one Professor or Reader and one Lecturer for starting post-graduate course.

a) In the Department of Agad Tantra - As, college is having 04 eligible teaching faculty in the Department of Agad Tantra (01 Professor, 01 Associate Professor and 01 Assistant Professors for UG course and 01 Professor

for PG course) and **there is non availability of 01 additional lower faculty in the concerned subject which is mandatory as per sub regulation (7) of regulation 6 of (PG Ayurveda Education) Regulation 2016 and is not fulfilling the criteria for issuance of permission to start new PG course in the department of Agad Tantra** .

Therefore, Board decided to issue letter of Permission to Govindbhai Jorabhai Patel , Ayurveda College and Research Centre B/h G.I.D.C, New Vallabh Vidyanagar, Taluka; Dist. Anand-388121, Gujarat (Inst. ID. AYU0035) to start 01 new PG course with 06 seats in the subject namely (i) **Shalyatantra - 06 seats and Denial of Letter of Permission to start 01 new PG courses with 06 seats in the subject namely i) Agad Tantra - 06 seats** from the academic session 2023-24 under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020.

7. Further, in accordance of the regulation 6 (2) (i) (i) of "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019 vide letter of even no. **dated 05.10.2023** a letter was sent to your college to submit the fixed security deposit worth **Rupees 50 Lakhs to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely (i) Shalyatantra - 06 seats** in favor of National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine for the period of three years, in response of the same you have furnished the fixed security deposit in favor of the National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine of **rupees 50 lakh through online payment mode vide RTGS number - HDFCR52023100693380079 transferred by HDFC Bank, Gujarat dated 06.10.2023 (for a period of three years) and informed the same vide letter no. GJPIASR/2023/1395 dated 06.10.2023.**
8. Therefore, Letter of Permission is issued to Govindbhai Jorabhai Patel , Ayurveda College and Research Centre B/h G.I.D.C, New Vallabh Vidyanagar, Taluka; Dist. Anand-388121, Gujarat (Inst. ID. AYU0035) to start 01 new PG course with 06 seats in the subject namely (i) Shalyatantra - 06 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24 and **Denial of Letter of Permission to start 01 new PG courses with 06 seats in the subject namely i) Agad Tantra -06 seats from the academic session 2023-24** under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, subject to following conditions:
 - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum **15% of Post-graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 18 seats in 03 PG courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2022-23 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
 - III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
9. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
10. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARIISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or subsequent year.**
11. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
12. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25:-**
 - i) all the requirements of the enforced regulations namely "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019
 - ii) all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - iii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016;
 - v) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;

13. This permission to start 01 new PG course with 06 seats in the subject namely (i) Shalyatantra - 06 seats from the academic session 2023-24 as stated above for the first admitted batch of 2023-24 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against these courses appear for the first final examination of the said courses and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 35 of the NCISM Act 2020.
14. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
