**Subject:- Application dated 31.10.2021 received from The Director Prof.(Dr.) C.H Babaria, Govindbhai Jorabhai Patel Institute of Ayurvedic studies and Research Behind G.I.D.C, New Vallabh Vidyanagar Dist. Anand-388121, Gujarat (AYU0035) seeking permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, National Commission for Indian System Of Medicine to start 02 New PG courses namely (i) Panchkarma (06 Seats) (ii) Kayachikitsa (06 seats) under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 and section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2022-23.**

**Sir/Madam,**

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

Therefore, I am to refer to your application ref. no. GLPIASR/2021/ dated 31.10.2021, on the subject cited above and to say that to verify the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff and other facilities available at college namely **Govindbhai Jorabhai Patel Institute of Ayurvedic studies and Research Behind G.I.D.C, New Vallabh Vidyanagar Dist. Anand-388121, Gujarat (AYU0035) to start 02 New PG courses namely (i) Panchkarma (06 Seats) (ii) Kayachikitsa (06 seats) under section 13A of the IMCC act, 1970 and section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2022-23** on 19.05.2022 & 20.05.2022 through hybrid mode by the visitation team of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine.

1. As per the direction of **President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM)**, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019", the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under, and on the basis of Relaxation policy issued by the NCISM dated 16.03.2022.
2. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the third Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 04.08.2022. On



careful examination of the assessment report, Board decided to issue the Letter of Intent (LOI) for conducting 12 seats in 02 PG courses.

3. In view of above Letter of Intent (LOI) is issued to **Govindbhai Jorabhai Patel Institute of Ayurvedic studies and Research Behind G.I.D.C, New Vallabh Vidyanagar Dist. Anand-388121, Gujarat to start 02 New PG courses namely (i) Panchkarma (06 Seats) (ii) Kayachikitsa (06 seats) under section 13A of the IMCC act, 1970 and section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2022-23**, under section 29 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations there under, subject to the condition that following conditions shall be fulfilled before issuance of Letter of permission (LOP) for the academic session 2022-23, failing which the Letter of Permission (LOP) shall not be issued and Letter of Intent (LOI) issued shall be deemed to be withdrawn.
  - i. The applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of infrastructure for teaching and training facilities as specified in "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016.
  - ii. The applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG course.
  - iii. The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019.
  - iv. The applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016.
  - v. The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020.
4. The applicant is also need to submit the requisite fixed security deposit as specified under the section 6 (3) (j) (ii) of notified Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019" **on demand before issuance of Letter of Permission (LOP).**
5. The college administration is to ensure that no student is admitted in the PG course till the formal permission i.e. Letter of Permission (LOP) is granted.
6. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) will visit the college virtually, physically or Hybrid mode to verify the compliance/ fulfillment of the above conditions by the applicant and issuing/not issuing the LOP will be considered.
7. In the event, the applicant college fails to comply with or satisfy the conditions of the Letter of Intent; the Letter of Intent shall be deemed to have been withdrawn without further intimation to the applicant.
