A Report on - Transitional Curriculum Program

About the event:

The Transitional Curriculum Program, which was introduced by the CCIM in collaboration with the Ministry of AYUSH, was successfully conducted by the Academic Cell of GJPIASR as part of the Transitional Curriculum for newly admitted first-year students of the B.A.M.S. professional course. 


